Please note: Pedigree registrations <u>must</u> be carried out via our society website (www.irishshorthorn.com) <u>online animal register</u> or <u>by paper form.</u> Forms can be found under 'publications' on the society website and downloaded. This has been instructed and checked by the Department of Agriculture Food and Marine.

Forms can also be posted out to breeders if required. <u>Over the phone registrations are not permitted.</u>

Online Registrations:

- Step 4: Choose "ROI or NI animal registration"
- Step 5: Complete the form presented
- Step 6: Click "Submit answers"
- Step 7: Wait for Shauna to make contact re payment once registrations are complete.

Please submit paperwork even if you are waiting on DNA/genotyping results to avoid LATE registration penalty fees. Please do not wait until club/society sales to submit registrations.

Breed Journal 2024:

Tibial Hemimilia - TH:

TH testing is optional for breeders, if you do not wish to test and there is no record of a test on both the **Dam** and **Sire** bloodlines, you can still receive your pedigree cert with "TH STATUS NOT VERIFIED" stamped on it.

To test animals for the TH genetic defect, follow these steps:

- 1. Collect Hair Samples: Get a hair sample from each animal.
- **2. Prepare the Samples**: Place each sample in a separate zip-lock bag (freezer bag). Include a piece of paper in each bag with the following details: Animal TAG Number, Herd Number. Your Name, Address, Phone Number, TH Test Required for This Animal

Results Preference: Specify that results should be sent to both the breeder and directly to the society if you wish.

- **3.** Packaging and Posting: Once the samples are prepared, send them to the following address: TH Testing, Weatherbys Scientific, Unit F1 M7 Business Park, Newhall, Naas, Co. Kildare.
- **4. Contact Information**: If you need any assistance or have questions about the TH testing process, you can contact Weatherbys on **+353 (0)45 875521**.
- **5. Payment**: Weatherbys will reach out to you directly to arrange payment for the testing
